

## History of Student Organization

As an organization of the Batangas State University representing the students of the Chemical Engineering Department, the Junior Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers-Batangas State University live up to their philosophy, "Like atoms we collide; like electrons we move; like bonds we share; like crystals we grow." This philosophy is pragmatic to all members of the organization that like atoms, we are socially interactive with one another, like electrons, we are constantly on the move, like bonds, we share strong relations with one another and like crystals; we grow through the years stronger than before.

First recognized as the PBMIT Chemical Engineering Society by 1997 until 1999, the Junior Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers-Batangas State University was established in 2000. Initially having members below a hundred, the number of the members of the organization grew as the population of the Chemical Engineering students grew. It was first made up of Chemical Engineering students until the year 2007 where the Food Engineering Department became an official part of the department. This year, the organization transitioned from being known as PIChE-JCB (Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers-Junior Chapter Batangas) into JPIChE-BatStateU (Junior Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers-Batangas State University). Along with the change of its name, the JPIChE-BatStateU also changed its logo to have more appealing features that reflect the organization. JPIChE-BatStateU is known for some of their signature activities like the ChEin Reaction and ChEmpodium.

The ChEin Reaction is composed of a series of events which includes the Chem Collision, STEMIQS, SIP, and ChExpertise. Through these events, the skills of junior and senior high school students in analyzing problems and presenting their works in front of an audience can be tested and trained. These events also aim to promote the chemical engineering course in the region.

Other activities like ChEnematography, Tutorials, Sem Ender Activities, JPIChE Trivia Quiz Bowl, Extension Programs, and ChE-Games are actively participated by the organization. Also, the organization hosts seminars that would help the growth of the members of the organization as future engineers.

The Junior Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers-Batangas State University continues to expand its versatility as a student organization of the university through the years and is still continuing in aiding the students of the Chemical Engineering Department in the fields of academic and extracurricular activities.
