



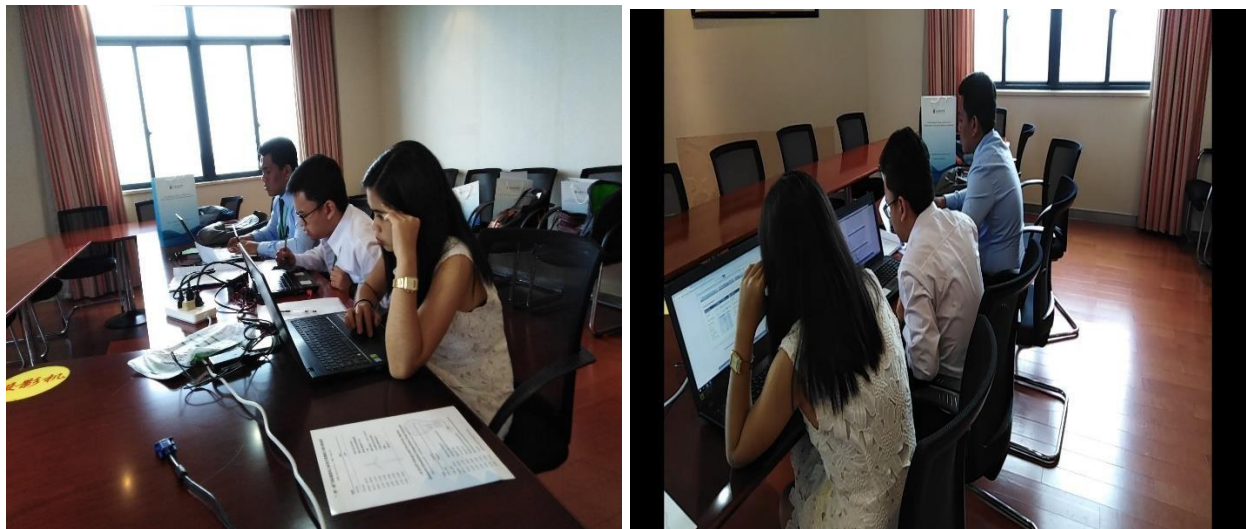

1st International Energy and Electricity Market Business Decision Simulation Competition & 1st Regional Association of Energy and Power (RAEP) Universities Summer School

Representative from Batangas State University, Electrical Engineering Department won 1st Prize (2nd Place) in the recently concluded 1st International Energy and Electricity Market Business Decision Simulation Competition held at Shanghai University of Electric Power, Shanghai China, July 12-13, 2019.

Team Red Spartans composing of Mr. Prudencio R. De Chavez, Jr., and Ms. Hazel M. Masangcay, 5th year EE students, and Mr. Hamdanie G. Impa, a 4th year EE student, together with their coach Engr. Ricmart V. Garbin, compete with 9 other team from different countries including China, Philippines, Vietnam, Thailand, Sri Lanka and Indonesia.

Last May 2019, Batangas State University was invited to participate in the preliminary round of the competition. The team compete with 43 different teams from different countries through an online business simulation game using a software called CESIM. After six challenging rounds, the 43 teams were trimmed down to 9 finalists.

The final round of the competition was held at Shanghai University of Electric Power, Shanghai China. The teams were then again given a simulation game different from the preliminary rounds. The teams were given 4 rounds and will be graded according to their cumulative profit.

The final scores were determined using the criteria 50% for the simulation results and 50% Presentation (which includes content, teamwork and overall presentation). A very challenging presentation was faced by every teams since time is limited to 8 minutes only. Presentation less or more than 8 minutes will have deductions in the final scores.
